

What you will need for your Workshop Dance Class at Drouin Dance Center!

Mommy & Me and Music, Movement & Play:

Please play clothes, t-shirt with pants or shorts and have bare feet.

Creative Movement, Ballet/Tap & Ballet/Jazz Combo:

Leotard and tights in any color, skirts are optional. Leotards and tights can be purchased at our studio, Finer Pointes (dancewear shop at 140 Preble Street in Portland), Target, Wal-mart, and Kohl's.

Shoes: pink leather ballet shoes, which can be purchased at our dance center (\$20), Please do not purchase the satin Isotoner-style slippers as they are too slippery on our wood floor and fall off the dancer's feet. Dancers can also have bare feet, if they prefer.

Ballet/Jazz Combo students will only need the ballet shoes for the workshop and will not need to purchase additional jazz shoes.

Ballet/Tap Combo students will also need tap shoes, which may be purchased at our studio for \$25.

Acro:

Please wear comfortable clothing if you do not own a leotard, and please make sure that your t shirt is not too large. Please wear either shorts or Capri pants and have bare feet.

Hip Hop:

Please wear a leotard with track/yoga/jazz style pants, capris or shorts, that are not too baggy. If you do not own a leotard, please wear a close fitting tshirt or tank top.

Please wear clean sneakers, if you do not already have dance shoes.

Adults:

Please wear comfortable clothing and clean sneakers for jazz and hip hop, if you do not already have dance shoes. For ZUMBA classes, please wear comfortable clothing and clean sneakers. No jeans, please.

**Please have longer hair tied away from the face.
All students are welcomed and encouraged to bring bottled water with them
into classes.**

Directions to Drouin Dance Center

WE HAVE MOVED TO THE SECOND FLOOR AS OF JUNE 1, 2010.

From Portland:

Take Brighton Avenue (Route 25) West towards Westbrook and continue to follow as Brighton Avenue becomes Main Street (you will pass Kohl's, McDonald's). Follow into Westbrook and bear left into a traffic circle at Rite-Aid. Continue to follow Main Street into downtown Westbrook (passing Riverbank Park, Dunkin Donuts, the post office, and Rent A Center). At the traffic light at the intersection of Bridge Street (CVS is on the left, Bridge Street is on the right), take a right onto Bridge Street.

Go over the bridge and the Dana Warp Mill is a long brick mill on the river on the left. Drouin Dance Center is located in the middle of the mill, on the second floor. You may enter the middle door (there is a green Drouin Dance Center sign at this door) or at the ramp entrance before that with the green awning. There is an elevator at this entrance. At the second floor, follow the signs to Drouin Dance Center.

From Gorham:

Take Route 25 East into Westbrook. At the traffic light intersection of Main Street, turn left onto Main Street and follow until the next traffic light, the intersection of Bridge Street (CVS is on your right). Turn left onto Bridge Street.

Go over the bridge and the Dana Warp Mill is a long brick mill on the river on the left. Drouin Dance Center is located in the middle of the mill, on the second floor. You may enter the middle door (there is a green Drouin Dance Center sign at this door) or at the ramp entrance before that with the green awning. There is an elevator at this entrance. At the second floor, follow the signs to Drouin Dance Center.

From Windham:

Take River Road into Westbrook and turn right onto Pierce Street. Follow Pierce Street to the end and bear right onto Bridge Street. Follow Bridge Street until it curves, and you will see the mill on the right.

Drouin Dance Center is located in the middle of the mill, on the second floor. You may enter the middle door (there is a green Drouin Dance Center sign at this door) or at the ramp entrance before that with the green awning. There is an elevator at this entrance. At the second floor, follow the signs to Drouin Dance Center.
